



Your DVR just got smarter.

New DVR Features:

Overlap Protection

Now you can record up to three scheduled programs that conflict less than 5 minutes. Your DVR will automatically clip the first few minutes of the lowest priority program.

- Set three program recordings. For example, one from 7-8:03pm and the other two from 8-9pm. The DVR will record all three programs; however the first three minutes of the lowest priority program recording from 8-9pm will be clipped from the recording.
- Find out which Scheduled Recordings will be clipped by looking for the (Clipped) indicator next to program title on the Scheduled Recordings Screen. (see screen below on left)
- Overlap protection feature can be turned off if you prefer. Select Menu twice on your remote, then choose Setup, then Guide Setup, and look for DVR Clipping. (see screen below on right)

Live Recording Extension

You don't have to worry about missing the end of your recording ever again! Now when you are setting a recording for a live event, your DVR will automatically ask you if you would like to schedule in extra recording time at the end of the event, just in case it goes overtime.

- Set a recording for a live event and the Live Recording Notice will appear. The default extend record time is 30 minutes, but you can choose to extend the recording by up to two hours. Then select Record with extended time. (see screen below on left)
- You can also choose to not extend the recording by selecting Record as planned, do not extend.
- Live Recording Extension feature can be turned off if you prefer. Select Menu twice on your remote, then choose Setup, the Guide Setup, and look for Live Program Notice. (see screen below on right)

DVR Skip Forward & Back

Jump forward or back with the touch of a button on your digital remote during playback of a DVR recording or while watching live programming.

- Page Up button: Playback skips 300 seconds (5 minutes) ahead. NOTE: While tuned to live programming, you can only skip ahead to the point of live broadcast.
- Page Down button: Playback skips 300 seconds (5 minutes) back.
- Skip Back button (sometimes named REPLAY or a counterclockwise arrow symbol): Playback skips 15 seconds back.
